

## Press release: Signing of the Grant Contract for the project ROMD00075 – HEALTHCARE "Healthy system for population healthcare"

On the date of 30.07.2025, we signed the grant contract of ROMD00075 – HEALTHCARE "Healthy system for population healthcare" project.

The project is financed by the European Union through Neighbourhood, Development and International Cooperation Instrument (NDICI), through Interreg NEXT Romania-Republic of Moldova 2021-2027, Programme Priority 2 – Social Development across Borders, Specific objective 2.2 - Ensuring equal access to health care and boosting the resilience of health systems, including primary health care, and promoting the transition from institutional to family and community based care.

**The project general objective** consists in improving the joint response to emergency situations in the cross-border area by providing intervention equipment and organizing joint workshops in the field of medicine.

The project partnership is formed by the following institutions from Romania and Republic of Moldova:

- Partner 2: Ministry of Internal Affairs from Romania;

The implementation period of the project is **31.07.2025 – 30.07.2027.** 

The total budget of the project is 1.554.454,52 Euro, of which non-reimbursable financing 1.399.009,06 Euro.

The project addresses the cross-border area between Romania and Republic of Moldova, with the following **results**:

- Rehabilitation and provision of medical equipment for the emergency room of the departmental public medical institution "Medical Service of the Ministry of Internal Affairs" from Republic of Moldova;
- Enhancement of training capacity through the purchase of intervention equipment;
- Organization of 6 joint workshops in the field of medicine.
