Memorandum of Understanding

on

Cooperation in the field of police education

between the

1. Implementation of projects in the sphere of academic as well as professional training programs based on mutual interest;
2. Organizing exchange programs and study visits for the students/personnel of law enforcement training/institutional and police officers;
3. Sharing information concerning courses and teaching methods;
4. Collaboration in scientific research in law-enforcement sphere.

The cooperation will be arranged in the following forms:

1. Organizing meetings, lectures, trainings, seminars and conferences on the basis of mutual interest of the Parties;

The Academy „Ștefan cel Mare” of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Moldova and the Legal Entity of Public Law - Academy of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Georgia hereinafter referred to as “Parties”;

Acknowledging the importance of strengthening the cooperation between the Parties and recognizing the value of international cooperation in the field of police education,

Guided by the wish to further develop the cooperation between two educational institutions,

Aiming to develop contacts between both institutions, to enhance cooperation, including in the framework of the Eastern Partnership Initiative,

Reaffirming the commitment to make better use of the bilateral and multilateral cooperation instruments available, and to promote experts' mobility by encouraging them to participate in different trainings and in other programmes/projects,

With the intention of offering a contribution to the development of the bilateral relationship with a constant exchange of information, experience and knowledge,

Have agreed as follows:

- I.** In accordance with the national legislation of the Parties and in consideration of the international duties, the Parties shall promote the cooperation in the following fields:
 1. Implementation of projects in the sphere of academic as well as professional training programs based on mutual interest;
 2. Organizing exchange programs and study visits for the students/personnel of law enforcement training/educational institutions and police officers;
 3. Sharing information concerning courses and teaching methods;
 4. Collaboration in scientific research in law-enforcement sphere.

- II.** The cooperation will be arranged in the following forms:
 1. Organizing meetings, lectures, trainings, workshops and conferences on the basis of mutual interest of the Parties;

2. Implementing exchange programs and study visits for the students/personnel of law enforcement training/educational institutions and police officers with the purpose of sharing knowledge;
3. Sharing experience and information in order to improve teaching process and methodology;
4. Exchanging results of scientific research and materials in police field;
5. Inviting to sports competitions and cultural events.

III. The costs related to the implementation of the activities within the framework of this Memorandum of Understanding shall be borne in each case on the basis of prior agreement between the Parties.

IV. The Parties shall provide each other with mutual assistance in the implementation of this Memorandum of Understanding.

V. The Parties shall designate respective contact points that shall meet at regular intervals and at least once a year in order to approve cooperation plans and exchange information about status of cooperation, which will be approved by mutual consent of the Parties.

VI. In the context of the provisions of the present Memorandum of Understanding, the Parties shall designate the following contacts between the parties:

VII. This Memorandum of Understanding may be amended or supplemented by mutual written consent of the Parties.

VIII. Each Party may denounce or suspend this Memorandum of Understanding by notifying the other Party in a written form, at least two months in advance.

IX. The present Memorandum of Understanding shall enter into force upon signature by both Parties.

X. The present Memorandum of Understanding does not present itself as an international treaty.

XI. Upon entering into force of this Memorandum of Understanding, the Joint Agreement between the Academy of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of Georgia and the Academy „Ștefan cel Mare” of the Ministry of Internal Affairs of the Republic of Moldova, signed on 10th of November 2007 in two original copies in Russian language, shall be terminated.

Signed at Tbilisi, Georgia on 2 June 2016 in two original copies in English language, each text being equally authentic.
